Built to exacting environmental standards, these are dwellings with a low carbon footprint, high energy and water efficiency, plus many luxurious touches such as underfloor heating, fibre optic broadband and electric car charging points. Arbor Park has been created to give homeowners a sense of community, with a gated play area for young children and many surrounding amenities in the village of Bodicote. Arbor Park has retained dozens of mature trees within and surrounding the development, attracting wildlife and preserving the area's natural beauty.

Set in glorious countryside

Bodicote is surrounded on two sides by fields and footpaths, giving you the opportunity to enjoy attractive walks and explore nearby villages.

Bodicote is a distinguished place to call home. Already a settlement at the time of the Domesday Book in 1086, it still boasts many beautiful buildings. The church of St John the Baptist has a chancel arch that dates from the 13th century, plus a tower with a ring of eight bells. Bodicote Mill is a water powered corn mill that has stood on the same site since the 18th century. Indeed, to walk the streets of this village is to walk back in time.

You'll soon discover that what makes Bodicote really stand out is its sense of community. There are two popular pubs, The Plough and The Horse and Jockey. The Bishop Loveday CofE primary school serves local families, and there are also two local day nurseries for younger children.



In Bodicote, you'll also find there are many other amenities that enhance your quality of life, from local shops and a hairdresser, through to Cotefield Nurseries and its popular coffee shop. Once you've experienced life in Bodicote, you'll never want to make your home anywhere else.

This is also a village that loves its sports: there are playing fields, a cricket pavilion and a local adult and youth football club. Rugby team, Banbury RFC, are also based locally.



Glorious walks along the canal

The walk from Arbor Park in Bodicote to the Oxford Canal is a peaceful and scenic escape. Starting in the park, you'll pass through quiet fields before reaching the canal. The towpath offers a relaxing stroll with lovely views surrounding greenery, making it a perfect spot for a short, calming walk.



A region to explore

There's so much to discover in Oxfordshire, especially within a short drive of Arbor Park. If you like to explore historic buildings, you'll be spoilt for choice. You'll be just over three miles from Broughton Castle, the ancient home of the famous Fiennes family, not to mention only 16 miles from Blenheim Palace, the breathtaking home of the Dukes of Marlborough and the birthplace of Winston Churchill. Nearby Aynho Park, a 400-acre estate designed by Sir John Soane, is now home to RH England and is a temple to high-end home design and furnishings, not to mention fine dining, wine tasting and even a dedicated juicery.

There's also plenty of culture to enjoy near Bodicote. Each year, Fairport's Cropredy Convention – and annual folk and rock festival – attracts up to 20,000 people over three days in August. The Mill Arts Centre in neighbouring Banbury puts on a great variety of shows, comedy and more, while The Light is an accessible cinema with an excellent programme of films, plus activities such as bowling, mini golf, adventure climbing and more.

If you're a stickler for fresh produce, Deddington has a hugely popular and award-winning farmers' market with over 30 stalls. And if you want to upgrade your cocktails, be sure to pay a visit to the Gin School at the Pinnock Distillery, where you can make your own bespoke spirits. Fashion enthusiasts will love the fact they'll be only half an hour from Bicester Village, the famous shopping centre where you can hunt for bargains from over 160 designer brands.

The “City of Dreaming Spires”

Oxford, the “City of Dreaming Spires,” is only a 45-minute drive from Bodicote. Known for its stunning architecture, cobbled streets and beautiful riverside setting on the Isis, it is home to arguably the most famous university in the world.

As a cosmopolitan city, Oxford is a great place to work and an even better place to enjoy. With lots of lively cafés, restaurants and cultural venues, there’s no shortage of things to do and see. From exploring medieval colleges to punting down the river; experiencing the atmosphere of quaint taverns to hunting for treasures in antiquarian bookshops, you’ll never tire of what the writer Max Beerbohm called the “little city of learning and laughter”.

Oxford is also an excellent place to shop. With bustling markets, lots of designer outlets, antiques centres and independent shops devoted to everything from crafts and hobbies to cheese and chocolate, this is a city with few rivals anywhere in England – or even Europe.




